

BOARD OF CANVASSERS MEETING OF MONDAY, JUNE 8, 2015

City Council, acting as the Board of Canvassers, met on Monday, June 8, 2015 to canvass the votes from the June 2 election. Those in attendance were Councilmembers Charles Kolb, Larry Smith, Richard Stevens, Becky Williams; Mayor James Taylor and City Clerk Michele Fluharty.

Taylor called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The first item of business was setting a recount bond. Smith made the motion to set the bond at \$100. Kolb seconded the motion and it carried.

Fluharty said the process has changed this year and one randomly-selected precinct must be manually counted. Fluharty put the keys from all four precincts in a bowl and Stevens pulled out the key for Precinct #69. The votes for Precinct #69 were manually counted and the final result was verified. The ballots were compared and accounted for before the precinct materials were resealed. Stevens made the motion to declare the election results. Kolb seconded the motion and it carried.

Fluharty said there is now a 48-hour recount request period before the official results can be certified. The Board of Canvassers will meet again at 6:45 p.m. on Monday, June 15 to certify the results.

Kolb made the motion to adjourn. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
