

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF JULY 3, 2017

The first regular July meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor James Taylor presiding was held Monday, July 3, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Denny Efaw, Ken Fletcher, Charlie Kolb, Ray Shadrick and Becky Williams.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the previous meeting and they stood approved as read.

Mayor Taylor introduced Donna Rinehart as the new Main Street Director.

The first item on the agenda was the public hearing on Ordinance #429 which amends the zoning map. Kolb made the motion to read the heading only. Efaw seconded the motion and it carried. Taylor read the heading and then asked for any public comments. None were heard or received. Fletcher made the motion to adopt Ordinance #429. Efaw seconded the motion and it carried. The ordinance changes seven parcels of property surrounding and adjacent to the North Marion Senior Center from Industrial to Commercial 3 at the request of the property owners.

In New Business, Budget Revision #1 for the FY 2017-18 Coal Severance Fund was reviewed. Fluharty said this revision adjusts the unencumbered balance and must be submitted to the State by July 15. Kolb made the motion to approve the Coal Severance Fund Budget Revision #1 which moves the surplus funds into the Street Department account. Fletcher seconded the motion and all approved.

The outstanding bills were the final item on the agenda. Efaw made the motion to approve the payment of the bills as presented. Fletcher seconded the motion and it carried.

Efaw asked when the demolition of the Wintergarden was slated to begin and Taylor said July 11 is the start date.

Shadrick asked about the lettering on the new cruiser and said he would like to see them all lettered the same. It was agreed to get the lettering done locally, if possible.

Fletcher made the motion to adjourn. Kolb second the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
