

## **COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 19, 2016**

**The second regular January meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor James Taylor presiding was held Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. due to the Martin Luther King Day holiday. Council members attending were Denny Efaw, Ken Fletcher, Charlie Kolb, Richard Stevens and Becky Williams.**

**City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.**

**In New Business, Taylor recommended that Diana Hayes and Lora Michael be reappointed to the Board of Zoning Appeals. He said there are three other openings on the Board and applicants are being sought. Stevens made the motion to reappoint Hayes and Michael to three year terms on the Board. Efaw second the motion and it carried.**

**Taylor said it is time to begin work on next fiscal year's budgets and asked if council could come at 6:00 p.m. on February 1 for a budget work session. Everyone agreed.**

**The outstanding bills were reviewed. Efaw made the motion to pay the outstanding bills as presented. Fletcher seconded the motion and it carried.**

**Councilman Efaw asked about issuing permits for ATV use in Mannington. Taylor said that issue was addressed by a previous council and they voted it down. He added that he does not want to reopen an issue that has already been decided.**

**The Buffalo Street Bridge lights are still off. Taylor will check with the contractor who built the new Southside Bridge to see if they will reconnect them.**

**Kolb made the motion to adjourn. Efaw seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m.**
