

## COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 5, 2015

The first regular October meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor James Taylor presiding was held Monday, October 5, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Denny Efaw, Kenneth Fletcher, Charlie Kolb, Richard Stevens and Becky Williams.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the last regular meeting and they stood approved as read.

There were no visitors.

In department reports, Superintendent Ted Nice said they plan to put in the new water line to Whetstone next week, weather permitting, and they are getting their equipment ready for winter. Fluharty said she finally received the check from the State Treasurer's Office for Unclaimed Property in the amount of \$6424.01. The money was deposited in the General Fund because there was no detailed information about the original payments.

In Old Business, the revised proposal from D & R Construction (formerly Manley Made) for the demolition of the Northview Bridge was reviewed. Taylor said the project was delayed because Dominion did not remove their gas line until recently. In that time, the price for scrap metal declined drastically. Stevens made the motion to accept the revised bid for \$4,900. Kolb seconded the motion and it carried.

In New Business, Taylor asked for authorization to advertise for bids to replace the roof and gutter system on the city annex. Fletcher made the motion to authorize the bids. Efaw seconded the motion and it carried.

The outstanding bills were approved for payment in a motion by Efaw. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried.

Stevens made the motion to adjourn. Efav seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:07 p.m.
