

COUNCIL MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 19, 2016

The second regular monthly meeting of the Mannington City Council with Council at Large Charlie Kolb presiding was held Monday, September 19, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Other council members attending were Denny Efaw, Richard Stevens and Becky Williams. Mayor Jim Taylor was absent due to recent surgery.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the previous meeting and they stood approved as read.

Lisa Zukoff, candidate for WV State Senate, was introduced by Shawn Curry. She gave a brief presentation on her qualifications and asked for support in the upcoming election. Phil Mallow, a candidate for House of Delegates, distributed campaign materials.

In Department reports, Superintendent Ted Nice said that Eddie Price is back to work and the repairs to the Brookside Bridge are finished. Nice also reported that there was vandalism to the trailhead bathroom and he would like the chief to review the cameras to determine who was responsible since one of the cameras is pointed directly on the door. Kolb said he would direct Chief James to review the films tomorrow.

In Old Business, the final reading and public hearing on Ordinance #424 was the first item on the agenda. Efaw made the motion to read the heading only. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried. Fluharty read the heading. Kolb asked for any comments and none were received. Williams made the motion to adopt Ordinance #424 which adopts the new State Building Code. Stevens seconded the motion and all approved.

The public hearing on and final reading of Ordinance #426 which adopts the 2016 codified ordinances was next. Efaw made the motion to read the heading only. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried. Fluharty read the heading. Kolb asked for any comments and none were received. Stevens made the motion to adopt Ordinance #426. Efaw seconded the motion and it carried.

In New Business, the Fall Clean-Up Day was discussed. Efaw made the motion to set the Fall Clean Up on Saturday, October 8 and to authorize two dumpsters for the day. Williams seconded the motion and it carried.

The outstanding bills were reviewed. Efaw made the motion to pay the bills as presented. Williams seconded the motion and all approved.

Efaw made the motion to adjourn. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
