

COUNCIL MEETING OF FEBRUARY 2, 2015

The first regular February meeting of the Mannington City Council with Mayor James Taylor presiding was held Monday, February 2, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at city hall. Council members attending were Charlie Kolb, Larry Smith, Terry Starsick, Richard Stevens and Becky Williams.

City Clerk Michele Fluharty read the minutes of the previous meeting and they stood approved as read.

There were no visitors.

There was no old business.

In New Business, Mayor Taylor recommended that Sally Kolb and John Yost be reappointed to 3-year terms on the Planning Commission. Starsick made the motion to reappoint Yost and Kolb. Smith seconded the motion and it carried.

The next item on the agenda was General Fund Budget Revision # 3. Kolb made the motion to approve the revisions as presented. Stevens seconded the motion and it carried.

The outstanding bills were reviewed. Kolb made the motion to pay the bills. Smith seconded the motion and it carried.

The Water Street swinging bridge was discussed. Starsick said he spoke to Don White who said there was a liability issue with the bridge. Starsick suggested that the

City look into purchasing the bridge so that it could be replaced. Fluharty is to check with the City's insurance carrier.

Mayor Taylor reported that the gas line under the old Northview Bridge is to be removed this month and the bridge should be down by March.

Starsick made the motion to adjourn. Kolb seconded the motion and it carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
